industry expert **Stephen Wambua** leads the team of irrigation specialists now based at D&S HO in Nairobi who offer full support to the D&S Group including consultancy, system design, drawings and project delivery expertise.

The irrigation segment offers a full range of irrigation options that can be combined with existing D&S technologies including solar powered pumping, water treatment and waste water recycling so that partners can maximize the benefit of their water resource. All products are held in stock for distribution throughout the Group and several large projects have already been successfully completed.

# **St Francis Nanofiltration System**

**D&S HO Water Treatment Division** has in July successfully commissioned a large de-flouridation system at **Little Sisters of St. Francis Learning and Hospital Community Centre** at Kasarani in Nairobi. The plant was financed by D&S partner **DOW Chemicals** in conjunction with **KIWASH-USAID** as a CSR initiative for the institution. The water treatment system comprises of a  $15\,\mathrm{m}^3/\mathrm{hr}$  Ultrafiltration pretreatment process before Nanofiltration to remove the fluoride.

Nanofiltration is a recent technological advance that demineralizes water of undesirable elements without the high energy input and water rejection rate normally associated with reverse osmosis (RO) processes. Thought to be the first Nanofiltration system ever installed in Kenya, the plant was commissioned by U.S Undersecretary of Commerce **Gilbert Kaplan** with D&S Technical Director **Eng. Philip Holi** also in attendance along with representatives from DOW chemicals.

## **ABM Factory Project**

Innovative engineering is a corporate priority at D&S and the Head Office based **Engineering Division** under Technical Director **Philip Holi** has recently been busy executing some complex projects for industrial partners with specific customized requirements. Foremost amongst these is an **automated cooling system** for battery manufacturer **ABM** utilizing a number of pressure, flow and temperature sensors to operate a series of solenoid valves that automatically regulate and direct water for cooling from variable speed drive pumps. The system helps the factory achieve optimal conditions for its manufacturing process.

The system is monitored and controlled by a proprietary **Dayliff advanced PLC/HMI touch screen control panel** with components supplied by **Siemens** and **Scheinder**. System design and programming was carried out by R&D Manager **Gilbert Barasa** and his team at HO who oversaw the successful project from inception to commissioning.

# **D&S Mwanza 10th Anniversary**

**D&S Mwanza**, situated in the Tanzanian lakeside town, has recently had cause for a double celebration, the first being its **10**<sup>th</sup> **anniversary** since inception back in 2008, and the second being the move to smart **new premises** on Nkurumah Road. # Staff Profile - Stuart Eastwood



Long serving non-Executive director Stuart Eastwood recently retired from the D&S Board during which time he made a considerable contribution to the Group's development. Stuart is Kenyanborn, his father being a Standard Bank executive and after primary school in Nairobi went to the UK

for his secondary education before qualifying as a lawyer. He then returned to Kenya to join leading law firm Daly & Figgis before being recruited by The Coca-Cola Company as its Africa-Middle East legal council in 1980. Moving into the business arena, Stuart served Coca-Cola for 23 years in various capacities, lastly as President of the company's East and West Africa business and was one of the company's most senior executives in what, at the time, was one of the world's biggest corporations.

Stuart's international and commercial experience was very valuable in providing advice to the Group as it has expanded and regionalised. He is a real doer and his mantra 'Execute, Execute, Execute' has become a slogan at D&S! During his contributions to board meetings and management conferences over the years Stuart's excellent presentation and communication skills have certainly helped to raise general standards.
